Dear Parent/Guardian:

For your information, the NH State Law now requires:

RSA 200:32 A complete medical examination by a licensed physician before entrance into the public school system and thereafter as often as deemed necessary by the local school authority.

RSA 200:30-1 The immunizations listed below **MUST** be completed **PRIOR TO SCHOOL ENTRY**:

- 4 doses of DTP and/or Td – 1 dose on or after age 4
- 4 doses of Polio vaccine – regardless of age, any combination OR
- 3 doses Polio vaccine last dose on or after age 4 of all IPV or OPV schedule
- 1 dose of Measles vaccine given on or after the first birthday
- 1 dose of Mumps vaccine
- 1 Dose of Rubella vaccine
- 3 doses Hepatitis B (for those born after January 1, 1993)

**Additional:**

- 1 dose Varicella (chicken pox) vaccine for entry into grade K and 6<sup>th</sup> grade (except if had the disease)
- 1 dose measles (for entry into K, 1<sup>st</sup>, and 7<sup>th</sup> grades)
- Td (Tetanus / Diphtheria) booster (10 years after the last DPT/Td)

**For Preschoolers (age 3-5 years old):**

- 4 doses of HIB vaccine and 1 dose of Varicella (chicken pox) vaccine or report of disease
